RESOLUTION 2022-07-02**

*A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FY2022-23 FEE SCHEDULE APPROVED JUNE 9, 2022*

**PURPOSE:** It is the intent of this Resolution to compile all fees charged by the City, including fees for services, licenses, permits, and development applications. It is also the intent of the Resolution to repeal all resolutions or parts there of that list any fees charged by the City, including fees not listed in this Consolidated Fee Schedule. It is not intended by this Resolution to repeal, abrogate, annul, or in any way impair or interfere with existing provisions of other resolutions, ordinances, contracts, or laws regarding penalties, bonds, insurance, fines, deposits, lease payments, Special Improvement Districts, and other monies received or paid by the City under contract, except to effect modification of any specifically listed herein. The fees listed in this Consolidated Fee Schedule supersede all present fees whether or not listed herein, except as excluded in the previous sentence.


