## PLEA AND REQUIREMENTS UNDER RULE 11, UTAH RULES OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE

- 1. Above named Defendant enters a plea of guilty to the charge(s) on the above noted case, and acknowledges the following:
  - a. I am NOT represented by counsel and understand that if I cannot afford one, an attorney will be appointed by the Court at no cost to me. I KNOWINGLY WAIVE MY RIGHT TO COUNSEL (no appointment of counsel on infractions).
  - b. I have a RIGHT AGAINST COMPULSORY SELF-INCRIMINATION and WAIVE the same by entering my plea.
  - c. I have a right to the PRESUMPTION OF INNOCENCE, SPEEDY PUBLIC TRIAL before an impartial JURY (no jury in the case of an infraction), and to CONFRONT and CROSS-EXAMINE in open court witnesses against me. to COMPEL the ATTENDANCE OF WITNESSES on my behalf and WAIVE the same by entering my plea.
  - d. I understand the nature and ELEMENTS of the offense to which I am entering a plea and that upon trial, the prosecution would have the burden of PROVING each of those elements BEYOND A REASONABLE DOUBT: and that my guilty plea is treated as an ADMISSION of those elements.
  - e. I acknowledge my plea is VOLUNTARILY made, in that no force or coercion has been used by anyone to make me plead guilty.
  - f. I understand the terms of the PLEA AGREEMENT.

Once Defendant has complied with all conditions of probation, the charge herein shall be dismissed and Defendant is allowed to withdraw Defendant's guilty plea. In conformance with Utah law, a plea in abeyance is reported to the Utah Driver's License Division. According to their policy, a plea in abeyance disposition is not reported to insurance companies unless the violator holds a Commercial Driver's License (CDL).
